

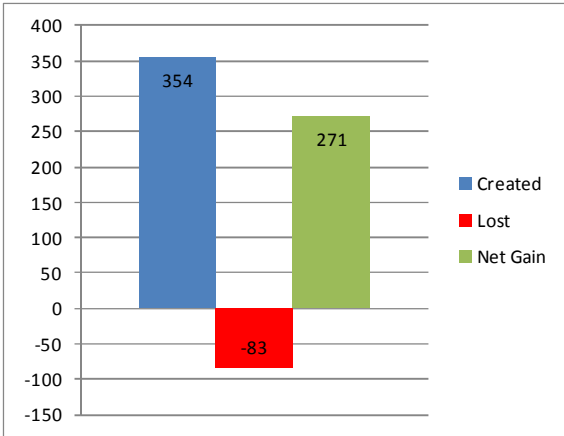


Workforce Planning Board Monthly Labour Force Survey Employment Stats Covering the Month of April 2011

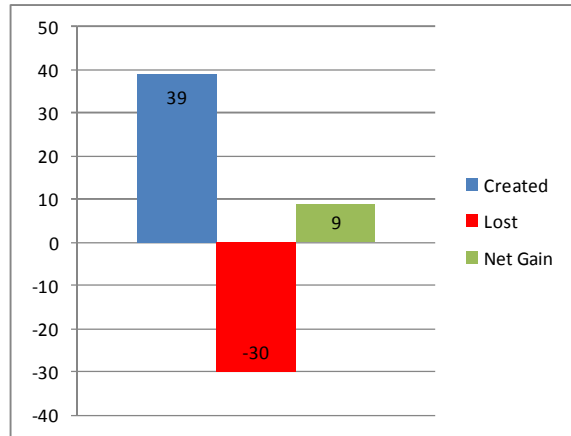
Here are highlights from the survey conducted in May 2011 covering the month of April 2011.

Overall Jobs Gained/Lost



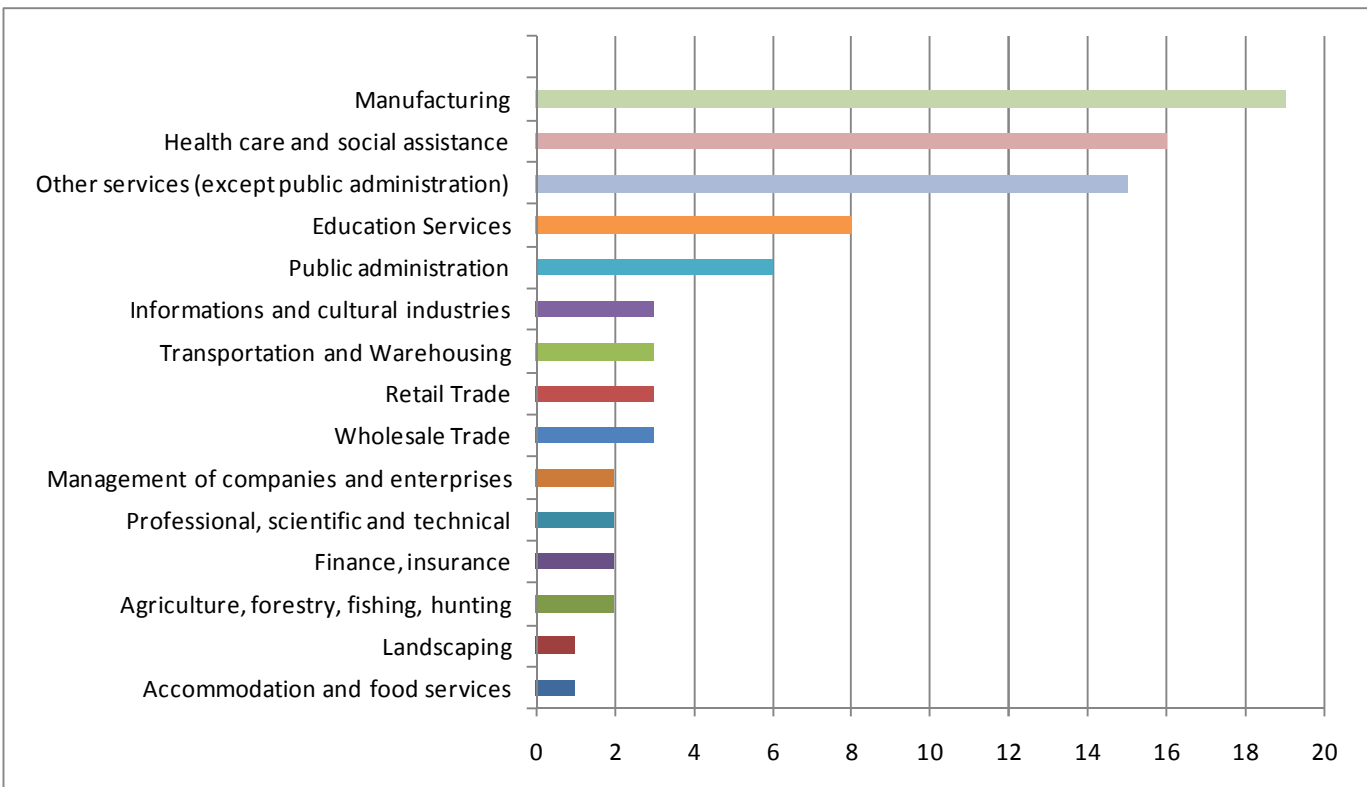
The total number of jobs created, both full and part-time, was 354 while the number of jobs lost was 83 for a net gain of 271.

Manufacturing Jobs Gained/Lost

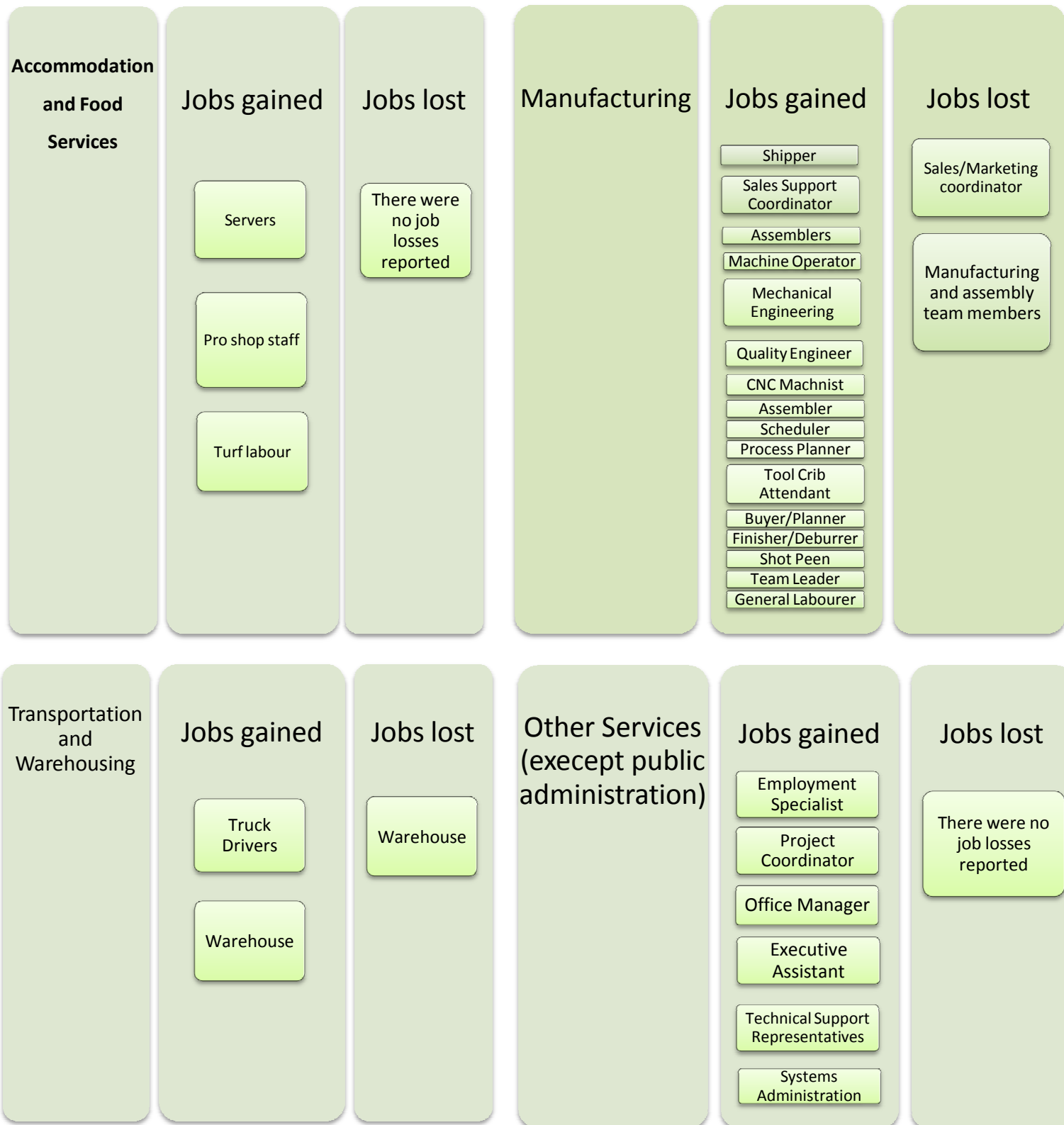


The number of manufacturing jobs created, both full and part-time, was 39 while the number of jobs lost was 30 for a net gain of 9.

The following chart shows the number of companies from each sector who participated in the survey:



The following charts show a sample of the types of occupations added or lost during the month of April by the top 4 sectors. Accommodation and food services had the largest increase of 150 positions. Transportation and warehousing reported the largest loss of 45 positions:
