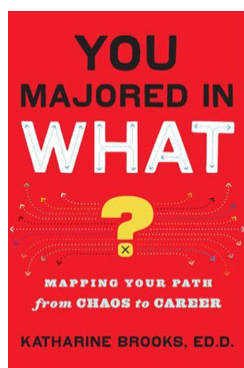

Written by a career counsellor, this book outlines how to decipher the value in one's degree and move past the myth that degrees dictate career direction. A refreshing look at how to plan your career.

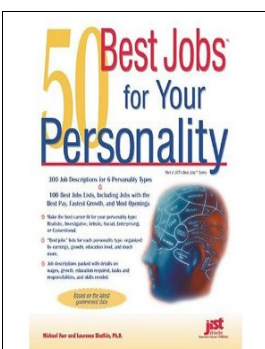
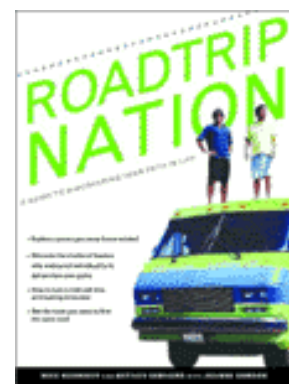
